### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

#### **The RallyMoto Roadbook Navigation Challenge (Tarenig Rally) - 25th June 2017**

Organised by RallyMoto Ltd, Club ref: 0754

RallyMoto Ltd, a Recognised ACU Promoter, will hold an Open All Terrain Rally event held under an All Terrain Rally Permit, the ACU National Sporting Code these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may be issued.

Eligibility: Open to any rider who is a member of an ACU Affiliated Club or the SACU and who is in possession of an appropriate ACU licence or obtains a One Event Licence for this event (£15). Riders who are not current members of an ACU Club may obtain membership of RallyMoto Club at a cost of £5.00 (This is just a basic club membership)

Any rider who does not hold a current A.C.U or SACU Enduro licence must complete an application for a day licence for which a £15.00 fee is payable in advance with this event entry.

Full licence holders must show their current licence at signing on or a day licence fee will be charged; for insurance purposes there can be no exceptions to this rule.

I/we understand and accept that as the Supplementary Regulations state the insurance cover for this event will be Premium Cover.

Start: Sweet Lamb Rally Complex, Glanrhyd, Llangurig, Llanidloes, Powys, SY18 6SY

Course: Approx. 140 - 200km of hard based tracks, fire roads and roads. An average speed will not exceed 25mph.

Event format: The event is a roadbook navigational event and will form a round of the RallyMoto Cup for the Rally Class and a round of the Big Bike Rally Challenge for the Adventure Class.

Course: The course is over varied terrain and the Rally Class course is longer and more technical than the Adventure Class. The course will have set checkpoints and the riders must maintain their minute at check points.

Sighting Lap: There is no sighting lap.

Timing: There are no timed sections.

GPS Tracking: Competitors will be GPS tracked.

Penalties: There will be penalties for excessive speed in “Speed Zones”, deviation from the roadbook mileage (Km), being late at checkpoints. (There are no penalties for arriving early at a checkpoint)

Signing on: all riders and marshals must sign on before commencement of the event and, times will be given in the final instructions. Entry lists will be published at [www.rallymoto.co.uk](http://www.rallymoto.co.uk) and notified via email. Signing on will be available on Saturday evening from 4pm and on Sunday morning from 7.30am

Briefing: A briefing and roadbook will be available at 6.00pm. For those riders arriving on Sunday morning a roadbook and riders briefing will take place at 9.00am.

Start time: Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> – 9.30am First bike away.

Machine Examination : From 8.00am on Sunday morning.

Lighting: All bikes must have front and rear lights fitted and operational. All machines must comply with current ACU All Terrain Rally Regulations as per the current A.C.U. handbook. Bore and stroke must be marked on cases to enable sound metering to be carried out.

Tyres:- Front and rear must be “Enduro” type to current FIM specification or a commercially available tyre and have an E Mark and / or DOT (American Department of transportation) approval and DOT number must be moulded on the tyre wall.

Adventure Class are advised to have an off road orientated tyre.

**No motocross tyres will be allowed.**

Noise: This event is being held on Forestry and Private land, and we want to show everyone concerned that we are professional and considerate users of the area.

Machines will be randomly tested as per ACU Control of Exhaust Noise Regulations

Any machines appearing to have modified or aftermarket silencers will be automatically tested.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED TO ANY RIDER WHOSE MACHINE FAILS SOUND TESTING.

Any request for a refund must be made 7 days before the event with a doctor's certificate.

Event Cancellation: If the event is cancelled by the organiser's a full refund will be given to all competitors, less a £20.00 administration fee.

Classes:

Rally Class – a round of the RallyMoto Cup – course distance approx 200km

Rally Lite Class - course distance approx 200km

Single over 575cc – a round of the Big Big Rally Challenge – course distance 140km

Multi Class over 575cc – a round of the Big Big Rally Challenge – course distance 140km

For the Adventure Class (big Bike Rally Challenge) a basic roadbook holder can be hired from RallyMoto - it is to be returned.

Route Markers: There are no route markers. Marshals instructions must be complied with when crossing rights of way, including stopping if requested. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification.

Re-fuelling: Must only take place in the designated / paddock area. All crews must provide a suitable fire extinguisher. No smoking in the refuelling area and parc-ferme.

Refueling is available on the course and max distance to fuel is approx 50km.

Environmental Mat: As per ACU Enduro Regulations 3.16. A piece of carpet will act as an environmental mat, please remember to take it home with you.

Refreshments: a catering van with a full range of hot and cold snacks will be available at the start area from 07h00 - 17h00.

Camping: Only basic camping will be available at the start / paddock area at Sweet Lamb.

Toilets: Will be located in the paddock area.

Important: Course cutting, abuse of officials, foul language, etc will result in immediate exclusion.

Entries: Riders can only enter online via the RallyMoto Web Site web site entry system - linked to Fabian 4's entry and payment system. (<http://www.rallymoto.co.uk.co.uk>)

Entry fee: £130.00 (or £145.00 with an ACU Day Licence)
